





Peter Opsvik—The inventor

Peter Opsvik's vision reshaped the way we think about sitting. In the 1970s, while many designers pursued the "perfect" posture, Opsvik pursued movement. His creations, including the iconic HÅG Capisco and HÅG Capisco Puls, invite the body to shift naturally through multiple positions, all within a single chair.

When he introduced the HÅG Capisco in 1984, Opsvik challenged traditional sitting habits with an unconventional, sculptural form. Decades later, this playful, ergonomic design remains one of Europe's most celebrated seating innovations—a true classic that continues to move with the times.

Rise, sit, perch.

Its flexible height range makes it effortless to shift between sitting, standing, and perching, encouraging natural motion throughout the day. By varying your posture, you stay energized, focused, and comfortable. It's an intuitive way to keep your body active and your mind engaged, no matter how you work.

Balance that moves with you.

The distinctive saddle seat of the HÅG Capisco and HÅG Capisco Puls promotes a naturally balanced posture that encourages movement in every direction. It supports the spine's natural curve, opens the hips, and keeps muscles active yet relaxed, reducing the strain often caused by traditional sitting.

Backrest

Combined with armrest, forming a strong cross shaped profile. Open curves and proportions allowing freedom to move and support in all directions.

Seat


The saddle-shaped, cross-form seat invites movement in every direction. It tilts the pelvis forward to promote a natural posture, freeing the legs for greater mobility and effortless flow between sitting and standing.

Footbase

Organic in its orientation, it's designed with the HÅG Capisco in mind and has the unique signature of Peter Opsvik. It gives stability and ease of movement and alternative levels for the feet.

Sustainability

Crafted with 50% recycled materials, built from few easily disassembled parts, and 85% recyclable, HÅG Capisco proves that performance and sustainability can move in perfect harmony.



The HÅG Capisco is a chair with a very special and recognizable shape. It has become a classic and we love that they are made to last, and made to be repaired. Ergonomically, the chair allows us to work an entire day at the desk without becoming uncomfortable. We chose coral upholstery for our office. Ergonomic

Constructed with a height-adjustable, high-strength shell, HÅG Capisco Puls provides the same unrestricted movement as the upholstered HÅG Capisco, but in a lighter and more minimalist form.

Comfortable

The HÅG Capisco Puls features a durable plastic seat with integrated cushion and optional Comfort Pad or Extra Cushion upgrades—choose the support level that best fits your space and needs.

Adaptable

Built for environments that demand mobility, cleanliness, and ergonomic support. Its lightweight frame moves easily, and its smooth surfaces wipe clean in seconds—making it a smart choice for medical labs, salons, and studios.

Sustainable

Designed with circularity in mind, it's made from 93% recycled plastic and is 95% recyclable, cutting its carbon footprint by 70% (from 187 lbs $\rm CO_2e$ to just 55 lbs $\rm CO_2e$).
